

**PROCLAMATION
OF THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA
IN HIS CAPACITY AS EMERGENCY SERVICES DIRECTOR
TERMINATING EMERGENCY RULES AND REGULATIONS
ADOPTED ON APRIL 9, 2020**

WHEREAS, On March 4, 2020, the Health Officer of Los Angeles County determined that there is an imminent and proximate threat to the public health from the introduction of COVID-19 in Los Angeles County and declared a Local Health Emergency and the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors concurrently proclaimed the existence of a local emergency for the County of Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, California Governor Gavin Newsom declared a State of Emergency due to the spread and effects of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, On March 17, 2020, the City Council of the City of Arcadia ("City Council") adopted Resolution 7300, ratifying the City Manager's proclamation of a local emergency and declaring a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, City of Arcadia Municipal Code Section 2213.3.1 and Resolution 7300 authorize the City Manager, as Director of Emergency Services, to make and issue rules and regulations on matters reasonably related to the protection of life and property as affected by the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2020, the City Manager issued a "Proclamation of Emergency Rules and Regulations" ordering in part that essential business who interact with the public wear face coverings and practice social distancing; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, the Health Officer of the County of Los Angeles issued an updated "Safer at Home" order that requires, among other rules, that employees of essential businesses wear masks and that essential businesses establish certain social distancing protocols.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that, in order to avoid confusion and inconsistency with the County Health Officer's "Safer at Home" order issued on April 10, the City Manager's "Proclamation of Emergency Rules and Regulations" dated April 9 is terminated, effective immediately.

The County Health Officer's "Safer at Home" order applies within the City of Arcadia, and the City may take any lawful and available measures to enforce the County Health Officer's order within the City.
