Through Partnerships to Increase Public Safety

National Night Out gives residents a chance to meet the men and women behind the badge. In 2024, with sponsorship from the Shops at Santa Anita, the event was bigger than ever, featuring family-friendly activities and live music. Look out for another great event and partnership in August 2025!

Ongoing collaboration with the Arcadia Unified School District has also enhanced pedestrian safety near schools and parks. Newly painted yield lines (shark's teeth) in key locations encourage safer driving speeds in high-traffic pedestrian areas.

Through Economic Vitality

In 2024, property values rose by 4.5%, placing Arcadia among the top 15 cities in Los Angeles County for growth.

With rising costs, it's more important than ever to make the Arcadia dream more accessible with projects like Alexan Azalea, Alexan Arroyo, Huntington Village, and The Derby. Over 1,000 market-rate units and 96 affordable units will be available in the community.

Visitors will soon enjoy 266 new guest rooms at the Hilton Hotel and Hotel Tempo, further enhancing the city's vibrant landscape.

Through Prioritizing Community Health

Arcadia is home to world-class healthcare institutions that elevate community well-being. Through the monthly health education series and the first-ever citywide health fair, top providers connected with residents, offering essential health resources.

The Arcadia Fire Department remains a leader in emergency care, with a 93% success rate in administering pediatric anti-seizure medication.

Looking ahead, by spring 2025, the tennis courts at Tierra Verde Park will be converted for dual use, bringing expanded pickleball access to south Arcadia.

Through People & Community

City employees work tirelessly to serve and support Arcadia. In recognition of their dedication, the City Council committed to a multi-year investment to strengthen the City's workforce through attracting and retaining top talent.

New this year, streetlight banners honoring local military personnel were proudly displayed along Huntington Drive throughout November, paying tribute to hometown heroes who have served in the armed forces.
