WHAT IS AN ACCESSORY DWELLING UNIT?

An Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) is a residential dwelling unit that provides complete independent living facilities for one or more persons and is located on a lot with a proposed or existing primary dwelling. It includes permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking, and sanitation on the same parcel as the single-family or multi-family dwelling is or will be situated. In 2019, the California Legislature passed legislation allowing ADUs in all zones that allow single-family and multifamily residences and found that ADUs are an essential component in addressing California's housing needs.

WHAT PERMITS DO I NEED?

Building Permit Only:

1. Converted ADU from an existing accessory structure or from within the walls of the primary single-family dwelling (maximum of 50% of the existing home floor area).
2. Junior accessory dwelling units that are 500 sq.ft. or less.
3. Detached ADUs that are 800 sq.ft or less that comply with a 4'-0" side and rear setbacks and height regulations.
4. Conversion of existing non-livable spaces within a Multi-family Dwelling.

ADUs Subject to Zoning Clearance Permit (Planning Review):

1. Detached ADUs that are greater than 800 sq.ft.
2. Attached ADUs

A building permit is required upon approval of a Zoning Clearance Permit.

All ADUs must comply with Arcadia's Objective Design Standards.

HOW MANY ADUS CAN I HAVE ON MY LOT?

In a Single Family Zone:

1. One Attached ADU (may not be allowed with detached ADU or JADU); or
2. One Detached ADU or a JADU by itself; or
3. One Detached ADU with one JADU

In a Multifamily Zone:

1. If the lot has multi-family dwellings then there can be at least one (1) ADU and up to 25 percent of the existing multi-family dwelling units within portions of existing multi-family dwelling structures that are not used as livable areas.
2. Max two (2) detached ADUs with a minimum 4'-0" side and rear setbacks.

WHAT ARE SOME OTHER REQUIREMENTS?
