- There are recommended roofing materials in the Highlands. Options are concrete or stone coated steel which is a type of metal. Composition and Fiberglass shingles are not allowed. We have only allowed Composition roofs on homes that had one already existing, many of which are on homes below Virginia Rd. You need a permit from the City and Please get ARB approval prior to ordering roofing material. Roofing material/ style should go with the architectural style of your home.
