

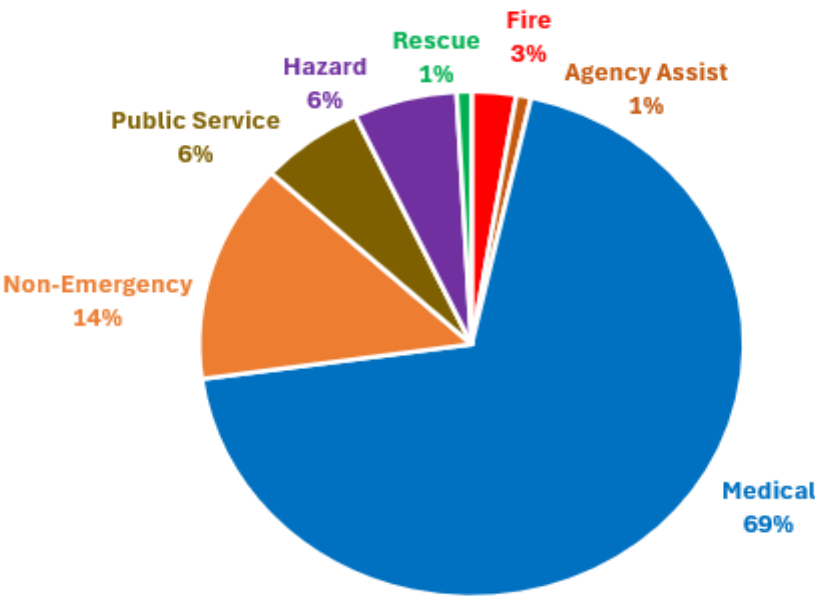

SUBJECT: Fire Department Weekly Report

The Arcadia Fire Department responded to a variety of emergency calls during the week of July 12 – 18, 2026. The following is a breakdown of incident categories recorded for this period:

Sunday, July 12

At 1:08 p.m., Engine 106 and Rescue Ambulance 106 responded to the 1100 block of West Huntington Drive for a reported overdose. Firefighters arrived to find a 29-year-old male unconscious and unresponsive. Paramedics arrived and initiated advanced life support protocols including, twelve lead electrocardiogram, blood glucose testing, intravenous access, medications and transport to USC Arcadia Hospital.

Monday, July 13

At 10:25 a.m., Engine 107, Engine 105 and Rescue Ambulance 105, responded to the West bound 210 Freeway at Baldwin Avenue for a traffic collision. Firefighters arrived to find two vehicles and two occupants involved, both occupants denying the need for treatment, evaluation or transport. Remaining fire units cleared and released the scene to the California Highway Patrol.

Tuesday, July 14

At 11:55 a.m., Engine 105 responded to a vegetation fire in the 100 block of Bonita Street. Firefighters arrived to find a palm tree smoldering. Firefighters utilized a small hose line to quickly extinguish the fire. No damage and no fire extension occurred. The cause remains under investigation.

Wednesday, July 15

At 7:17 a.m., Engine 106, Rescue Ambulance 106, and BLS 106 responded to a medical incident in the 1700 block of Holly Avenue. Fire personnel found a 73-year-old male with a chief complaint of abdominal pain. A full medical evaluation was performed, including vitals, twelve lead electrocardiogram, and comfort measures. The patient was transported by Rescue Ambulance 106 to USC Arcadia Hospital for further evaluation.

Thursday, July 16

At 9:04 p.m., Engine 105 and Engine 106 responded to a vehicle fire on the 210 Freeway. Upon arrival, units found a flatbed style truck and trailer transporting a tractor. The trailer's tires were well involved with fire. Our units deployed hose lines to extinguish the fire and successfully prevented the tractor from being damaged by the fire. The cause of the fire was attributed to brake failure. The scene was released to the California Highway Patrol to assist with towing arrangement for the vehicle and contents.

Friday, July 17

At 5:20 p.m., Engine 105 and Truck 105 responded to an elevator rescue in the 300 block of Second Avenue. Upon arrival, personnel found one victim trapped in a stalled elevator car between floors. Crews secured the power supply to the affected elevator car, manually lowered the elevator, then made non-destructive access to

remove the victim. The victim was not injured and did not require further medical care as a result of their extrication from the elevator.

Saturday, July 18

At 6:06 p.m., Engine 106 and Rescue Ambulance 106 responded to the 400 block of South Baldwin Avenue for a person down. Firefighters arrived to find a 16-year-old male that was unconscious. Paramedics arrived and initiated advanced life support protocols including twelve lead electrocardiogram, blood glucose testing, intravenous access medications and transport to USC Arcadia Hospital.
