2024-2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- L.A. County Registrar of Voters used the Library as one of three polling places within the community in the November 2024 election.
- The Library served as a space for community members to gather, access electricity, charge digital devices, and receive news updates during the Eaton wildfire in January 2025.
- The Winter Reading Challenge drew 126 participants who read 37,089 minutes.
- Bluetooth capability was added to the Library's Cay Mortenson Auditorium.
- Replaced 15 Windows 10 computers with Windows 11 for patron use.
- There were 107 Memory Lab sessions and the scanner equipment was most popular with 52 uses.
- A new digital activity table was purchased and installed in the picture book area of the Jerry Broadwell Children's Room.
- Repair Cafe offered a community workshop, providing sustainable ways to upcycle or repair existing items.

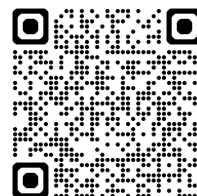
