- Be reliable and punctual, notifying Library staff **as soon as possible** if delayed or unable to keep my schedule.

- **Give full attention to tasks, which means I will not bring friends or siblings with me, nor will I use my phone or other devices while volunteering.**
- Be a cheerful and cooperative team player, asking staff for help when I have a problem or question, and providing suggestions as appropriate.
- Commit to a regular weekly volunteering schedule for the seven weeks of the Summer at Arcadia Public Library Program.
- Share my love of books and reading with other young people in the Library.
