Proposed Changes to Solid Waste Rates Starting July 1

To keep pace with the rising costs of providing hauling, handling, and disposal of Arcadia's waste and recycling for a community of nearly 57,000 residents, a five-year rate adjustment is being proposed to start July 2026.

Waste Management (WM) has served as the City's exclusive residential Single-Family and Multi-Family trash and recycling hauler since 1999. The City signed its current agreement in 2009 and has extended it over time. The most recent extension, approved in 2021, includes a five-year schedule of rate adjustments to comply with state requirements for organics. A third amendment is now proposed for the final five years of the agreement, which includes a phased labor fee on trash services and the WM contract, ending June 2031.

Beginning on July 1, 2026, the rate for Single-Family customers will increase by \$1.53 per month. Multi-Family service will go up by \$7.78 per month to \$9.17 per month depending on the type of service and how often trash is picked up. All fees in 2026 include rising labor, consumer price index, and disposal costs.

Compared to other San Gabriel Valley cities, Arcadia will still rank in the bottom third for Single-Family trash and recycling costs even after the rate increase. North Arcadia residents also receive free bear cart services after making the initial cart purchase, while neighboring cities typically charge \$45-\$60 per month for this service.

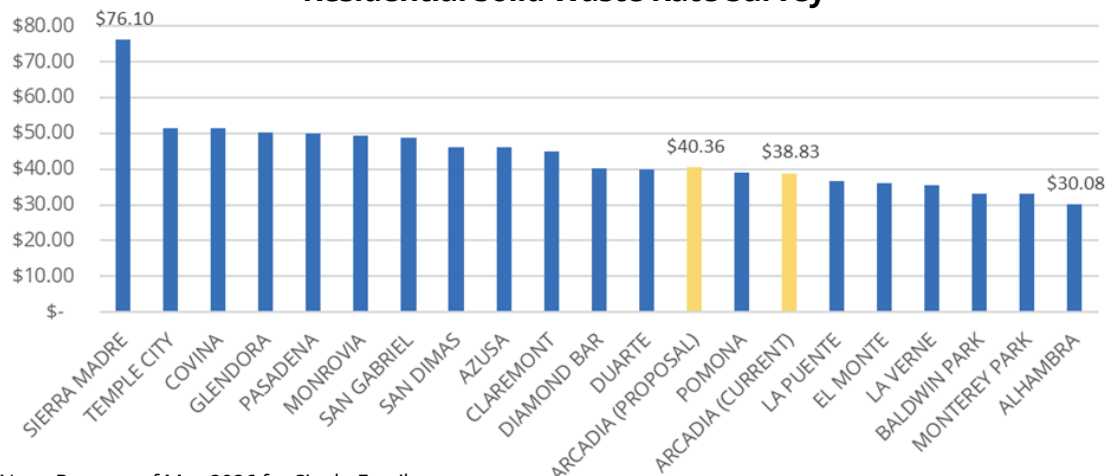
