ARCADIA

ARCADIA, CALIFORNIA, was part of an enormous land grant given to the San Gabriel Mission by the King of Spain and subsequently owned by several individuals. In 1875, Elias (Lucky) Baldwin purchased this 13,000 acre area, plus an additional 8,000 acres and helped to develop the Santa Anita tract that was to become the City of Arcadia.

The City was incorporated in 1903 and became a Charter City in 1951. It is an upper-middle class community of about 60,000 residents in an 11.2 square-mile area located 20 miles east of Los Angeles. It is a full-service community with its own police department, fire department and library. Arcadia functions under the City Council/City Manager form of government.

The information that follows offers a chronological portrayal of those elected and appointed officials who have been instrumental in shaping this outstanding community enjoyed by residents, businesses and visitors today.
