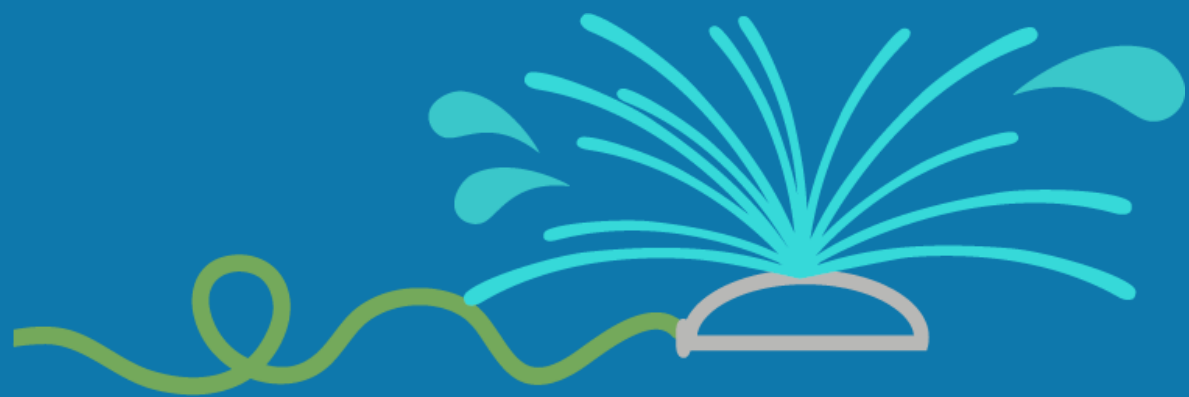


# INSPECTING COMMON Outdoor Leaks

## Pool & Spa

A leaky pool can lose up to 100,000 gallons per year!

- ✓ Inspect the shell of the pool for cracks or broken tiles.
- ✓ Look for soggy earth or uneven grass growth near the pool.

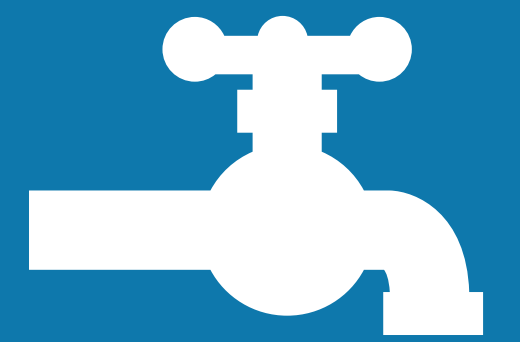


## Irrigation System

Broken sprinkler heads can waste thousands of gallons per month!

- ✓ Inspect your yard for depressions in the earth or uneven grass growth. This may indicate a leaky valve or broken/missing sprinkler hardware.
- ✓ Make it a habit to check for broken sprinkler heads and correct nozzles spraying water in the wrong direction.
- ✓ Inspect your irrigation valve box for standing water, mud, or algae growth. Hint: Overflow or runoff at the box is most noticeable after a sprinkler cycle.

## Forgotten Hose & Outdoor Faucets



An unattended hose can waste hundreds of gallons in an hour!

- ✓ Remember to turn water off at the hose bib when not in use. This also applies to hoses with shut-off nozzle attachments, which will leak if you forget to turn off water at the hose bib.
- ✓ Check outdoor hose bibs for drips and make repairs--every drop counts!
