



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Arcadia City Council Chambers, 240 West Huntington Drive, Arcadia, California, the Arcadia City Council will conduct a public hearing to receive input from the public regarding a proposed Amendment to the City of Arcadia’s Statement of Objectives and Projects for use of Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) funds for Fiscal Year 2025-26 to allocate \$290,000 of existing unallocated CDBG funds for an ADA Curb Ramp Project (“Curb Ramp Project”).

**BACKGROUND:** The City of Arcadia has an existing balance of \$290,000 of unallocated CDBG funds available to be allocated to local programs and projects. Any activities undertaken with CDBG funds must benefit low- and moderate-income residents, aid in the prevention/elimination of blight or substandard housing or improve disabled accessibility.

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT:** The City of Arcadia is proposing to allocate \$290,000 in existing unallocated CDBG funds for the Curb Ramp Project. The project will construct curb ramps at various locations in the City of Arcadia.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

The proposed Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2025-26 City of Arcadia Statement of Objectives and Projects will be considered at the May 19, 2026, City Council Meeting at 7:00 P.M. at the Arcadia City Council Chambers, 240 West Huntington Drive, Arcadia, California. At said time and place, an opportunity will be afforded to all those interested and the public in general to be heard. All persons are hereby advised that should any person desire to legally challenge any action taken by the Arcadia City Council with respect to the above matters and this public hearing, such person may be limited to raising only those issues and objections raised by such person or other persons at or prior to the time of the public hearing.

Pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) persons with a disability who require a disability-related modification or accommodation in order to participate in a meeting, including auxiliary aids or services, may request such modification or accommodation from the Arcadia City Clerk’s Office at (626) 574-5455. Notification 48 hours prior to the meeting will enable the City to make reasonable arrangements to assure accessibility to the meeting.

All persons are invited to appear and provide testimony at the public hearing. In addition, all persons are invited to provide written and other evidence at or prior to the public hearing.
