More Storytimes

African Folktale Storytime For Kindergarten – 3rd Grades Thursday, February 7; 6:30 pm

Celebrate Black History Month with an evening of wonderful African folklore. Listen to folklore favorites such as *Anansi the Spider* and make a fun craft to take home.

Bilingual English/Spanish Storytime For Ages 3 – 5 Years Thursday, February 21; 6:30 pm

Join us for a bilingual storytime with stories, songs, and activities in Spanish and English. This is a 30-45 minute storytime designed for ages three to five years.

Digital Storytime For Ages 2 – 5 years Monday, March 4; 6:30 pm

This is a traditional storytime with a twist as we incorporate use of digital resources such as an iPad and TumbleBooks into the storytime experience.
