guidelines

Street Photography

Entries are free!

- Each photograph (up to two per person) must be accompanied by an entry form, available on our website and at the Museum's front desk.
- The applicant must drop off and pick up their own photographs. The photographer's signature is required at drop off and pick up.
- Photograph must be original; taken by the applicant.
- Photograph must include a caption, under 150 words, describing the photograph. This caption will be used as the museum label accompanying the photograph in the exhibit.
- Entries must be framed and ready-to-hang with a wire hanger. (see image below) The Museum does not supply wire.
- Matting is optional but preferred.
- Photograph image (not the frame) *may not be less than* 11 x 14 inches.
- Images submitted without correct size, hanging capability or caption will be disqualified. They WILL BE MEASURED on arrival.
- Only entries that have made the final round, determined by the judges, will be exhibited in the Museum.
- Last pick up for entries which are not accepted for the exhibit is July 1.
- Digital creations and giclee prints are welcome; also prints on metal or canvas.
- All entries must encompass the theme of "Street Photography" as interpreted by the individual photographer.
- All ages and levels of experience are encouraged to submit.
- Each framed photograph will be covered with an insurance value of no more than \$200.00, carried by the Museum.
- Photographers must not have a "professional" background in photography.
- Wire hanging is required. The photographer gives Museum staff permission to make small repairs or additions to hanging mechanisms if needed.

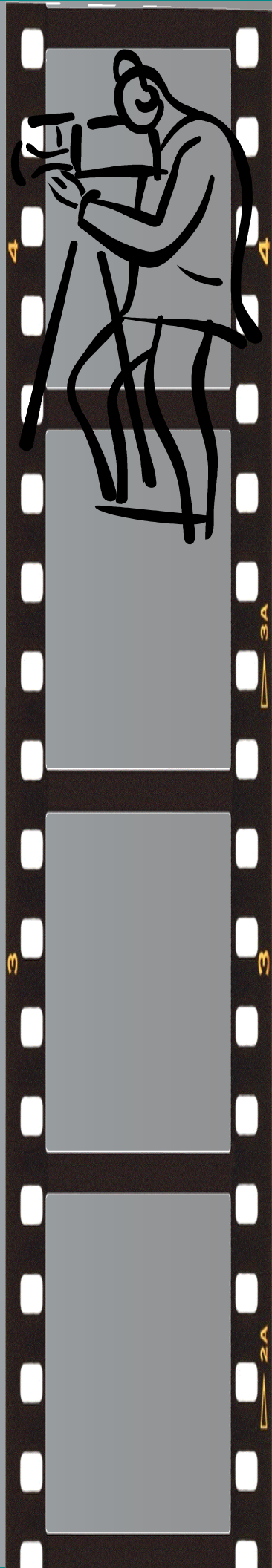
